

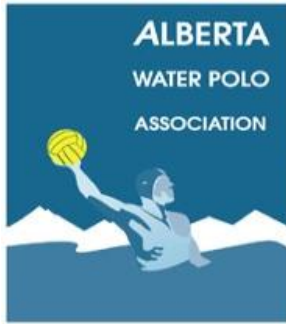
2011 Alberta Water Polo Christmas Camp

Location/Date:

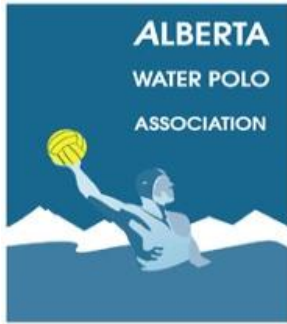
- Talisman Centre, Calgary.
